

guide to Horse Show Essentials what to pack



WHAT TO TAKE IN YOUR GARMENT BAG

- Hair ties, nets, etc.
- Jackets/Coats
- Shirts with monogrammed collars
- Show-quality breeches
- Gloves
- Belt
- Clean boots
- Knee highs or socks
- Boot pulls
- Boot polishing kit
- Fumis (rubber covers for rider's boots)
- Sewing kit

NOTE: *While at the show grounds, your pre- and post-competition apparel must be neat and professional. Shirts must cover midriff and you must still have your feet in closed-toe shoes.*

WHAT TO PACK IN YOUR TACK TRUNK

(Please wash tack trunk covers and wipe down trunks. It goes without saying – but we're saying it anyway – that ALL items should be clean!)

- Sheet
- Stable blanket
- Scrim sheet
- White show pads that fit your saddle properly
- Shipping wraps:
12"/14" for ponies, 14"/16" for horses
- Shipping halter
- Bridle with nameplate
- Martingale with nameplate
- Girth with nameplate
- Saddle with nameplate
- Equitation/jumping boots for horse
- APPROVED riding helmet
- Crop
- Spurs
- SmartPaks or supplements
- Medications
- Paddock Boots
- Half Chaps
- Square baby saddle pads for schooling
- Polo wraps
- Checks (your trainer won't write checks for you)
- First aid kit
